Duration of MBBS in Nepal

1. The duration of Nepal MBBS is a total of 5 years and six months.

Eligibility for MBBS in Nepal

1. The age of the medical student must not be less than 17 years.
2. Below 17 years of age, students are not permitted to apply for MBBS admission.
3. For getting MBBS admission in Nepal, the student must complete 12th grade.
4. Physics, Chemistry, and Biology should be the fundamental subjects in the sciences.
5. The candidate must score a minimum of 50% marks in all the subjects mentioned above.
6. Some of the medical universities in Nepal conduct entrance examinations.
7. The rules may be different from one university to another.

Intake for MBBS in Nepal

1. The session for Nepal MBBS commences in September.
2. The application procedure begins at least 60 days before the MBBS course starts.
3. Download the application form and duly fill it correctly.
4. Submit the required documents along with the application form.
5. Pay the fees for the MBBS program.
6. Now, the college will process your application for admission.
7. Students will not be allowed to comply with the required qualification criteria.

Recognition of Medical Universities in Nepal

The nepal medical universities are recognized by the following bodies:

1. National Medical Commission (NMC)
2. World Health Organization (WHO)
3. United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)

Documents Required for MBBS in Nepal

1. Birth certificate of the medical candidate.
2. 10th and 10+2-mark sheets of the medical candidate.
3. School leaving certificate.
4. Certificate of conduct.
5. Medical fit certificate.
6. Nationality proof in the form of Aadhar card, PAN card, voter I.D., or any other valid I.D. proof.
7. NEET scorecard result is mandatory, which the student must present during the time of admission.
8. Indian students are required to have a legal and valid Indian passport along with other vital documents.
9. For Indian students, there is no requirement to give a visa.
10. The university might ask for other vital documents. The students need to gather and submit them at the time of admission.

Admission Procedure for MBBS in Nepal

1. Every university in Nepal may have a different criterion for mbbs, and the process of admission may differ.
2. Although, the admission procedure is easy and transparent
3. Some of the changes are noticeably described in further points.
4. Some of the universities conduct no entrance examination for MBBS admission in Nepal.
5. Students can take Direct Admission in Top Universities in Nepal.
6. However, some other universities conduct exams, and students have to qualify in order to secure admission.

Important timeline for Nepal MBBS

1. Medical students must be aware of the critical dates for seeking MBBS admission in Nepal.
2. Medical candidates can start applying for MBBS admission in Nepal in June and July.
3. The MBBS university takes approx. 15 days either in July or in August to process the admission letter
4. 2 to 3 months is the time duration taken by the Ministry to issue the student VISA either in August or September
5. The beginning of the academic year is reserved for September or October.

Vital documents required to get the student visa Indian medical aspirants don't need a VISA permit to travel and stay in Nepal.

1. However, they are required to have a valid passport.
2. You must carry along with them or, if required, any other valid I.D. proof.
3. Students need to download and precisely fill in the application form.
4. The students will then receive the admission letter from the university.
